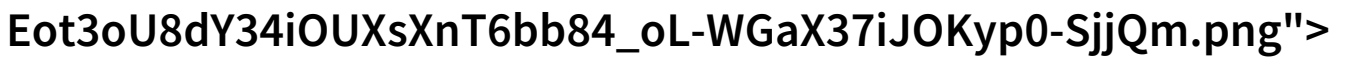


# 爷爷总是趴在妈妈身上睡觉英语-Grandpa

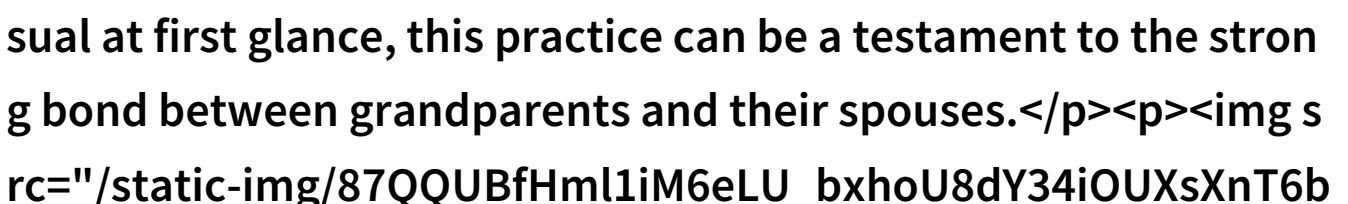
Grandpa's Unconventional Sleeping Habits: An English Exploration

choose to sleep in separate beds or even in different rooms. However, there are also instances where grandpas prefer to snuggle up close with their grandmas during slumber time.

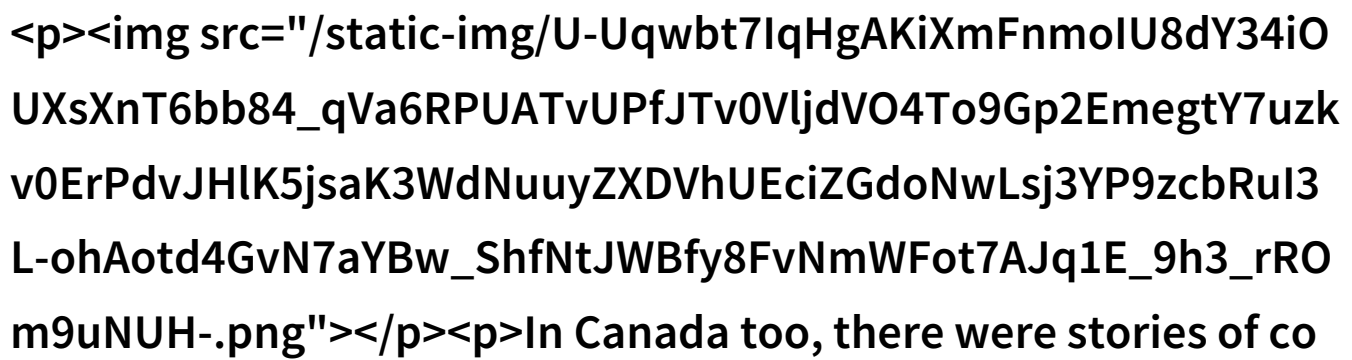

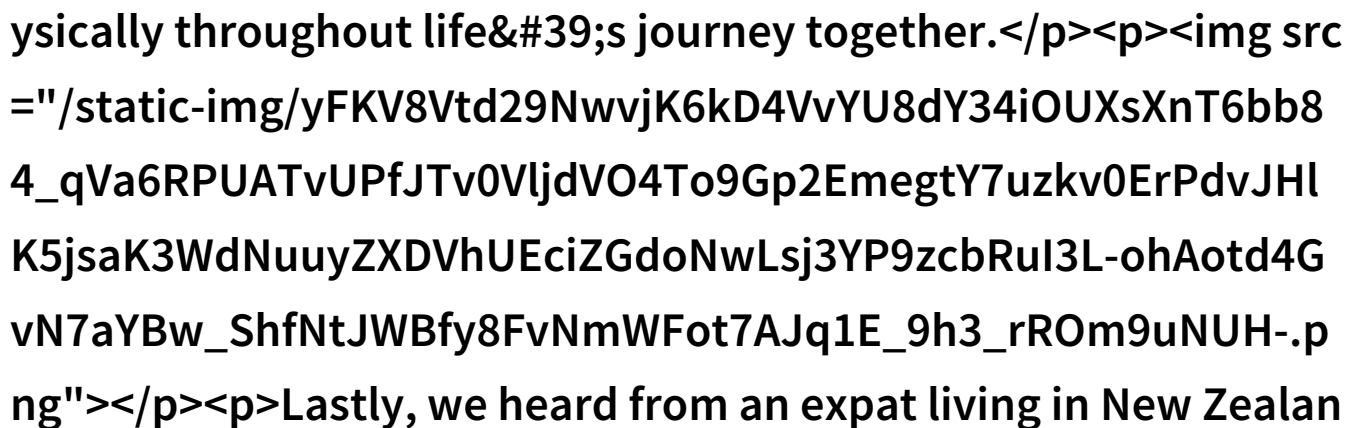

found it endearing but also slightly uncomfortable at times.



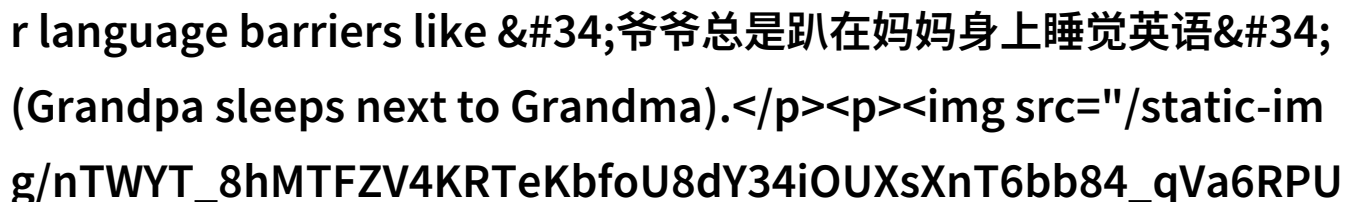
In Canada too, there were stories of couples who preferred sleeping together despite having separate bedrooms during daytime hours due to health reasons or personal preferences.
